AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the Service Employees International Union, Local 1; and to amend Section 7 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That under division (B) of Section 4117.10 of the Revised Code, this Council approves the collective bargaining agreement with the Service Employees International Union, Local 1, under the terms contained in **File No. 953-2022-A**, for the period from April 1, 2022 through March 31, 2025, and which provides, among other things, for an increase in the salaries and wages for members of the bargaining unit under the following schedule:

<u>Increase</u>	<u>Approximate Date of Increase</u>
2%	April 1, 2022
2%	April 1, 2023
2%	April 1, 2024

Bargaining unit employees on active payroll status when the agreement is ratified, will receive a one-time, lump sum payment of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), payable within sixty (60) days of ratification.

Section 2. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

Section 7. Service Employees International Union, Local 1. That salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

1	Animal Care Worker	17.10	18.16 <u>21.33</u>
2	Bridge Oiler	19.64	23.25 <u>25.55</u>
3	Canine Enrichment Specialist	16.56	17.63 <u>21.33</u>
4	Custodial Worker	17.89	20.01 <u>21.33</u>
5	Window Washer	17.89	23.99 <u>25.55</u>

Section 3. That existing Section 7 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, is repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
