

# Resolution No. 254-2020

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION  
Declaring the intent to vacate a portion of  
Gilbert Avenue.

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WHEREAS, this Council is satisfied that there is good cause to vacate a portion of  
Gilbert Avenue, as described; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the  
usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council declares its intent to vacate a portion of the  
following described real property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio and known as  
being a 10.00 foot alley, now known as Gilbert Avenue of part of Original Brooklyn Lot  
No. 34 as shown in the Laura L. Otis Subdivision in Volume 15 of Maps, Page 22 of  
Cuyahoga County Records, further described as follows:

Being all that portion of said Gilbert Avenue (10.00 feet wide) extending from the West  
line of West 61<sup>st</sup> Street (50.00 feet wide) westerly to the East line of West 63<sup>rd</sup> Street  
(60.00 feet wide).

Legal Description approved by Greg Esber, Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House  
Numbering Section.

Section 2. That this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and,  
provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to  
Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval  
by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest  
period allowed by law.
