AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 31 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by various ordinances, relating to salaries for various classifications.

FOR PASSAGE
AUGUST 19, 2026

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 31 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 1073-2021, passed November 29, 2021, Ordinance No. 1281-2022, passed December 5, 2022, Ordinance No. 338-2024, passed March 25, 2024, Ordinance No. 850-2024, passed August 7, 2024, Ordinance No. 47-2025, passed January 6, 2025, Ordinance No. 1169-2025, passed September 22, 2025, and Ordinance No. 524-2026, passed April 20, 2026, is amended to read as follows:

Section 31. That the salaries in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:

Section 2. That existing Section 31 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended by Ordinance No. 1073-2021, passed November 29, 2021, Ordinance No. 1281-2022, passed December 5, 2022, Ordinance No. 338-2024, passed March 25, 2024, Ordinance No. 850-2024, passed August 7, 2024, Ordinance No. 47-

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2025, passed January 6, 2025, Ordinance No. 1169-2025, passed September 22, 2025, and Ordinance No. 524-2026, passed April 20, 2026, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
