Purpose: To authorize the Director of Capital Projects to apply

to the District One Public Works Integrating

Committee for state funding to construct

improvements to portions of Wade Park Avenue from East 66th Street to East 118th Street; to apply for and accept any gifts and grants for this purpose from any public or private entity; to add any and all funds as

authorized by the Director of Finance; and to

authorize the Division of Purchasing and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record for right-of-way purposes any real property and easements necessary to make

the improvement.

Description: Wake Park Avenue, from East 66th Street to East

118th Street, approximately 2.2 miles will be rehabilitated to include roadway repair, new sidewalks, curbs, ADA compliant curb ramps and landings, new driveway aprons, roadway drainage, modified traffic signals and controls, and complete and green street elements. This will be an ODOT

administered construction project.
