Ord. No. 1022-2023

By Council Members Hairston and Griffin (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance to amend Section 138.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1266-02, passed January 27, 2003, relating to enhancing the City's ability to address nuisance properties.
