### Ordinance No. 1022-2023

# By Council Members Hairston and Griffin (by departmental request)

#### AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 138.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1266-02, passed January 27, 2003, relating to enhancing the City's ability to address nuisance properties.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1213-17 passed by Council on October 16, 2017 and subsequent ordinances of the same nature, provided for additional appropriations to enhance the City's ability to demolish residential and commercial properties; and

WHEREAS, in addition to demolition, there is a need to address nuisance properties by other means including but not limited to, making repairs to properties necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 138.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1266-02, passed January 27, 2003, is amended to read as follows:

Section 138.07 <u>City Demolition Repair, Demolition, and Board-Up</u>
Contracts

Notwithstanding any provision of the Codified Ordinances to the contrary <u>and subject to meeting any legal requirements</u>, the Director of Building and Housing may enter into contracts <u>to abate properties declared a public nuisance</u>, and for the boarding-up and/or demolition of structures which are found to be unsafe structures and declared public nuisances pursuant to the provisions of <u>Section Sections 367.05 or 3103.09</u> of the Codified Ordinances. Should the Director of Building and Housing <u>declare a public nuisance and find that an unsafe structure or property conditions constitutes constitute</u> an emergency situation, then the Director of Building and Housing may enter into a contract for the boarding-up and/or demolition of such an unsafe structure, <u>or the repair of the property conditions</u>, without advertising and without competitive bidding.

Section 2. That existing Section 138.07 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, as amended by Ordinance No. 1266-02, passed January 27, 2003, is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
