Dear Mayor Bibb:

I am pleased to inform you that the Trustees of The George Gund Foundation have approved a grant of \$5,000 to the City of Cleveland for the Junior Mayor's Association. This action has been taken in response to your letter and proposal received on February 3, 2025 and is made on the terms described below.

It is our understanding that the Junior Mayor's Association will engage a diverse mix of approximately 60 high school students from the Cleveland Metropolitan School District over the course of the program. Through various hands-on experiences and dialogue, students will engage in meaningful conversations with city leaders, learn how local government operates, and collaborate with peers to develop innovative, youth-centered solutions to real-world issues. Funds may be used for program costs over the course of the seven bi-weekly meetings.

Under the laws of our Federal Government relating to the Foundation, all grants must be used solely for educational, scientific, or charitable purposes. The objective of this grant, as indicated above and described in the background material you have provided, may be modified only with the Foundation's approval.

Grant payment cannot be made until the countersigned copy of this letter is received. In order to receive grant payment on the dates indicated below, please complete and return the Foundation's Grant Reporting form on the dates scheduled and email to cgsparro@gundfdn.org. Copies of the form may be downloaded from our website. Any additional correspondence should be sent to Ann K. Mullin, executive vice president, and should reference the 25-17 grant number. When there are press releases, photographs, and any published material about this grant and the work it has made possible, we would appreciate receiving copies.

It is our understanding that City of Cleveland has been determined to be a tax-exempt instrumentality of the State of Ohio as described in Section 170 of the Internal Revenue Code. If there is any change in this status and/or classification, please let us know promptly. In event of loss of tax-exempt status under Federal laws, or a change in classification, no further expenditures of grant funds are to be made and any unspent grant funds are to be returned to the Foundation.
