East 185th Street (Pawnee to Lake Erie), PID 113123

Ordinance No. **877-2020**

Purpose: Amend Ordinance 699-2019 passed July 24, 2019, relating to giving consent to City of Euclid to construct the improvement; and remove City of Euclid in making of the improvement; and grant consent to ODOT in making of the improvement; authorize the Director of Capital Projects to enter into enter into a Local Project Administration agreement with ODOT or any relative agreements as are necessary for the purpose and intent of this ordinance.

Description: Rehabilitation and streetscape improvements on East 185th Street (CR-24) from Pawnee Avenue to the shoreline of Lake Erie which includes pedestrian, public transit and bicycle enhancements in the Cities of Euclid and Cleveland, 3,710-foot or 0.70 miles. ODOT will bid, award and administer construction for E 185th St (Pawnee to Lake Erie), Part I and E 185th Street (Nottingham to Pawnee), Part II as one project. The improvements include new asphalt surface, pavement base repair, new curb, sidewalk, driveways, ADA compliant ramps, catch basin upgrades, waterwork, landscaping, pedestrian enhancements, public transit enhancements, curb bumpouts, and bicycle enhancements. The purpose of this ordinance is to allow E 185th Pawnee to Lake Erie located in both communities to be combined with E 185th Nottingham to Pawnee. One project will minimize disruption to residents and businesses adjacent to and within the service area.
