

Ordinance No. 982-2019

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend the agreement between the City of Cleveland and the Westshore Enforcement Bureau for additional reciprocal mutual aid services among the parties.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 1273-06, passed January 28, 2008 Council authorized the Director of Public Safety to enter into a mutual aid agreement with the Westshore Enforcement Bureau ("WEB") for reciprocal bomb squad and SWAT unit services within all respective areas, including Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and amended with additional legislation to include field force services to deal with crowd management, crowd control, and riot situations; and

WHEREAS, an amendment to the agreement is necessary to include the exchange of police services; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into an amendment to the agreement between the City of Cleveland and WEB, authorized under Ordinance No. 1273-06, as amended, to include the exchange of police services as a reciprocal service under the agreement. No other changes to the agreement are desired.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
