**Request for Authority to File a NatureWorks Grant Program
Application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for Impett
Park and to Obligate City Council Ward 17 Discretionary Funds as
Matching Funds**

Ordinance No: 808-2024

Legislative Purpose: Authorizing the Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects to file a NatureWorks grant program application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources for Impett Park, and to obligate City Council Ward 17 discretionary funds as matching funds.

Project Summary: The Ohio Department of Natural Resources NatureWorks grant program is funded through the Ohio Parks and Recreation Bond Issue that was approved by Ohio voters in November of 1993. The purpose of the grant is to provide reimbursement assistance for local government subdivisions for the acquisition, development, and rehabilitation of recreational areas.

It is to the City's advantage in the selection process to demonstrate specific authority was granted by the City Council to file an application to the NatureWorks grant program.

The NatureWorks grant program application will seek financial assistance for the purchase and installation of a new pavilion at Impett Park, electrical connection for outlets, and associated amenities such as picnic tables. The estimated total project cost and request for financial assistance is \$150,000.

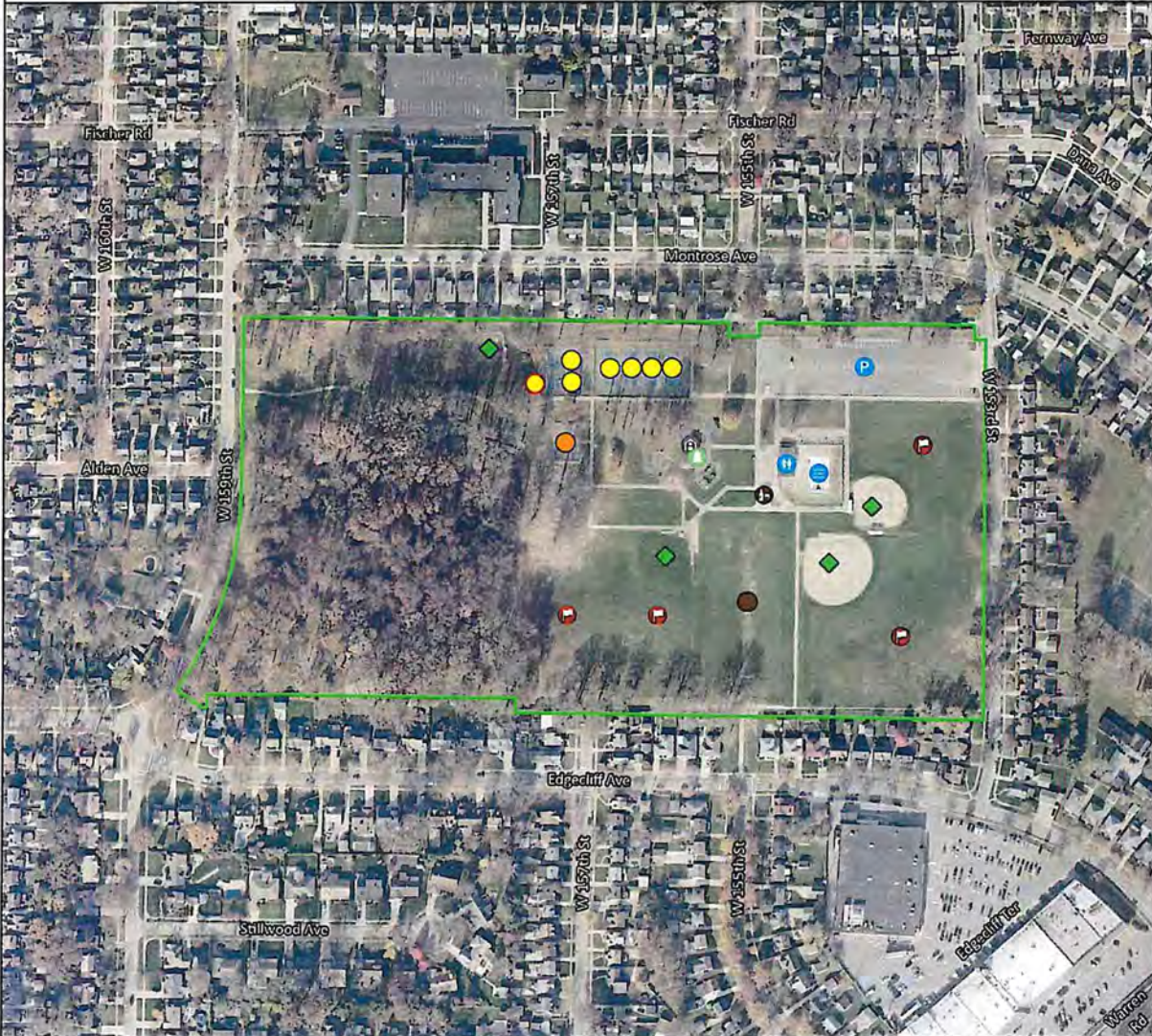
The NatureWorks grant program requires a 25% funding match for all awarded projects. While it is not required in the application process, it is to the City's advantage in the selection process to obligate this required 25% funding match by the City Council.

Councilman Charles Slife has offered the use of Ward 17 discretionary funds for this purpose, and subsequently seeks authorization to obligate \$37,500 of Ward 17 discretionary funds for the required 25% funding match.

Impett Park

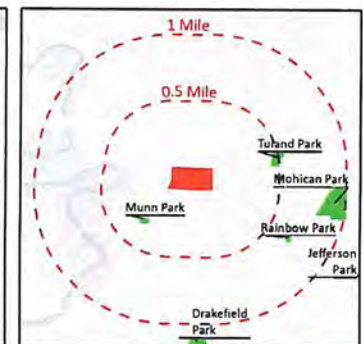
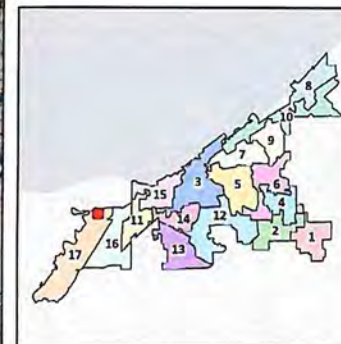
