

Ordinance No. 487-2020

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Thermo Electron North American LLC a part of Thermo Fisher Scientific, for the purchase of items and services required to convert the existing liquid chromatograph into a tandem mass spectrometer, including software and other necessary appurtenances, training, and maintenance for a period of three years, with two one-year options to renew the maintenance, exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That this Council determines that the within commodities and services are non-competitive and cannot be secured from any source other than Thermo Electron North American LLC a part of Thermo Fisher Scientific (“Thermo Fisher”). Therefore the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to make one or more written contracts with Thermo Fisher on the basis of its proposal dated April 30, 2020, for the purchase of items and services required to convert the existing liquid chromatograph into a tandem mass spectrometer, including software and other necessary appurtenances, training, and maintenance for a period of three years, with two one-year options to renew the maintenance, exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities, to be purchased by the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Utilities. The contract or contracts authorized shall be paid from Fund No. 52 SF 001 and from the fund or funds to which are credited the proceeds of the sale of future revenue bonds, if issued for this purpose. Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
