WHEREAS, this Council objected to the renewal of a D1, D2, D3, D3A an D6 Liquor Permit to H.I.M. Inc., DBA: Memphis Tavern, 4818-22 Memphis Avenue, patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44144, Permit No. 3845983 by Resolution No. 702-2024, adopted by the Council on July 10, 2024; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That objection to the renewal of a D1, D2, D3, D3A and D6 Liquor Permit to H.I.M., Inc., DBA Memphis Tavern, 4818-22 Memphis Avenue, patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44144, Permit No. 3845983 be and the same is hereby withdrawn and Resolution No. 702-2024, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
