License Agreement for GCRTA Bus Shelter at the City Park at Glenville Circle North Development

Legislative Purpose: To authorize the Director of Public Works to issue a

license agreement, renewable automatically from year to year, to the Greater Cleveland Regional Transit Authority (GCRTA) to construct and maintain a bus shelter within the new city park located at the

Glenville Circle North development.

Project Summary: The Glenville Circle North development includes

pedestrian enhancements on East 105th St. from Ashbury Ave. to Orville Ave. and on Ashbury Ave. from East 105th St. to East 103rd St. A new city park has been constructed at the corner of Ashbury

Ave. and East 105th St.

The GCRTA bus shelter will be located on an existing concrete pad within park property adjacent to an

existing bus stop along E. 105th St.

The license will allow GCRTA to construct and maintain a bus shelter on city property. The license shall renew from year to year unless terminated by either party. Licensee shall be responsible for all costs to install and maintain the bus shelter and

license area.
