Legislative Purpose:

Authorizing the Director of Public Works to grant a new access easement at Mercedes Cotner Park and payment of \$18,200 for release of existing access easement to The Cleveland Electric Illuminating

Project Summary:

The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company currently has an easement on City property (a portion of Mercedes Cotner Park) to access its property, which needs to be relocated to a different area of the park because City needs the current easement area for a park improvement project.

The existing easement was granted pursuant to Ordinance No. 1926-64, passed October 12, 1964, because of the vacation of a portion of Sunrise Road

The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company is willing to release its existing access easement if it is granted a new easement at City's preferred new access location and paid \$18,200 for release of its

existing access easement.


