Ordinance No. 1142-2021

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to apply for and accept a grant from Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services for the 2022 Body Worn Camera Grant Program; and authorizing the Director to enter into one or more contracts with Axon Enterprise, Inc. for services necessary to implement the grant.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to apply for and accept a grant in the approximate amount of \$106,935.61, and any other funds that may become available during the grant term from Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services to conduct the 2022 Body Worn Camera Grant Program; that the Director is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under the grant; and that the funds are appropriated for the purposes described in the summary for the grant contained in the file described below.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the summary for the grant, **File No. 1142-2021-A**, made a part of this ordinance as if fully rewritten, is approved in all respects and shall not be changed without additional legislative authority.

<u>Section 3.</u> That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to extend the term of the grant during the grant term.

<u>Section 4.</u> That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with Axon Enterprise, Inc. to provide equipment, video management, security and storage solutions, software, and training needed to expand the body-worn camera system for the Division of Police, including managed storage, warranties, upgrades, replacement equipment, maintenance and other related services during the grant term, in an amount not to exceed the grant proceeds accepted under this ordinance, for the Division of Police, Department of Public Safety.

Ordinance No. 1142-2021

Section 5. That under Section 108(b) of the Charter, the purchases authorized by this ordinance may be made through cooperative arrangements with other governmental agencies. The Director of Public Safety may sign all documents that are necessary to make the purchases, and may enter into one or more contracts with the vendors selected through that cooperative process.

<u>Section 6.</u> That the costs of the contract or contracts authorized by this ordinance shall be paid from the fund or funds to which are credited the grant proceeds accepted under this ordinance.

<u>Section 7.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


