EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Authorizing the purchase by one or more contracts of the implementation of the Fire Protection System replacement project, including installation, labor and materials, and programming, for the Division of Airports, Department of Port Control, for a period of two years, with one option to renew for an additional one-year period, which shall require additional legislative authority.

Background/Purpose:

The Department is engaged in a project to design and install a new fire protection system. The designed portion has been completed and the department is prepared to move forward with the physical installation of the required equipment and devices. The current fire system and devices have been in place for approximately 30 - 40 years.

Scope of Work:

To provide all associated labor, materials, and programming to execute the design of the new Fire Protection System. This will include a final passing inspection and as-built drawings in the Department's approved electronic format. The existing system is a Johnson Control Inc. (JCI), proprietary system that will require programing and site specific design changes by JCI and subject to final approval from Wadsworth Solutions the system designer.

Justification/Urgency:

This service is required to ensure that the Department of Port Control maintains safe and secure runways at Cleveland Hopkins International and Burke Lakefront Airports. This is also a FAA Part 139 regulatory requirement.

Anticipated Cost:

\$1,658,081.00

Schedule or Term of Contract:

Two years with a one year option that will require legislative approval.
