The Allen Estates is a proposed multi-phase development led by Frontline Development, a minority- and female-led development group, led by Sheila Wright. The proposal looks to develop an area of the Hough neighborhood leveraging off of the League Park project, through a multi-phase project with a mix of townhomes, mixed-use and commercial development.

This project will create affordable housing in a key neighborhood of the City, close to the amenities of League Park. In accordance with ARPA rules, the City will contract with an eligible private non-profit entity to assist this project.

By Spring 2022, the project looks to break ground on the initial phases of the project, which would include six townhomes and a mixed-use apartments over retail building on either side of E. 66th Street at Linwood Avenue. The apartment building would include 72 units, of which 15 (21%) would be affordable and the remainder market-rate.

In order to proceed with the project, they have identified a project gap of approximately \$4,000,000.

To assist with the project gap, the City would provide the following assistance:

Loan Forgivness:

The loan will be forgiven based on completion of construction and provision of appropriate affordable housing for a period of 30 years.
