Project Description

The purpose of this project is to expand Cleveland's Police and Mental Health Co-Responder Team to embed mental and behavioral health services with law enforcement to better respond to individuals in crisis in the community. Our current Co-Responder teams pair a crisis worker with two police officers to respond to incidents where someone may be having a mental health crisis. After the scene is determined to be secure by first responders, the Co-Responder Team arrives to assess the person who may need attention, or talk to their family members if they have left the scene. They can have the person transported directly to a mental health facility or provide them with resources that may help them. They also do follow-up calls when the incidents occur while they are not on duty. We propose to use this funding to add two Co-Responder Teams to our current program and utilize them in an innovative way. The funding will pay for two additional crisis workers. Cleveland Police will assign four additional officers to the program at their own expense. The new teams will be rovers that will ensure city-wide coverage and provide special attention to locations that need additional resources. We currently have one team assigned to each of the city's five Neighborhood Police Districts. Although this provides coverage for the entire city, there are breaks in coverage when teams have regular days off, when their shift ends, or when the needs are more than the current teams can handle. The rover teams will support the districts when their assigned team is not on duty. Additionally, when hot spots arise, the rover teams can be a force multiplier. They can be assigned to concentrate on particular locations that regularly require assistance, such as the airport, and at hot spots determined by District Commanders and partner agencies. Our key partners are the Cuyahoga County Alcohol Drug Addiction Mental Health Services (ADAMHS) Board, and Begun Center.
