That the Clerk of Council is authorized to enter into an agreement Section 1.

services necessary to assist Cleveland City Council with automated phone calls and text

messages to relay pre-recorded messages to Cleveland residents, for a one year period

beginning February 1, 2022 and concluding January 31, 2023, with three one-year options

to renew.

That the cost of said contract shall not exceed \$40,320 and shall be Section 2.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure Section 3.

and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to

Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by

the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period

allowed by law.
