

# Ordinance No. 170-2022

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2020-54 with Hi-Lite Airfield Services LLC to provide labor and materials necessary for painting and paint removal on roadways, runways and other paved surfaces for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 878-2019, passed August 21, 2019, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. RC 2020-54 with Hi-Lite Airfield Services LLC to provide labor and materials necessary for painting and paint removal on roadways, runways and other paved surfaces for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 878-2019 requires further legislation before exercising the first option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the first option to renew Contract No. RC 2020-54 with Hi-Lite Airfield Services LLC for the requirements for an additional year to provide labor and materials necessary for painting and paint removal on roadways, runways and other paved surfaces for the various divisions of the Department of Port Control. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 878-2019 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
