ORDINANCE NO: 269-2022

LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE: This legislation is necessary to enter into an agreement with Neighborhood Leadership Institute (NLI) to implement educational, recreational and cultural programs in various school buildings during evening hours. In addition, NLI conducts workshops in conjunction with the division’s Youth Development Project and oversees the Summer Tennis Program.

CONTRACT TERMS: June 2022 - May 2023

PREVIOUS CONTRACT: \$234,118 - 2020 Program Year
(\$197,511 for School as Neighborhood Resources; \$16,607 for Tennis Program and \$20,000 Youth Leadership Cleveland)

THIS YEARS REQUEST: \$289,511 (\$247,511 for School as Neighborhood Resources; \$22,000 for Tennis Program and \$20,000 Youth Leadership Cleveland)

PROGRAM PURPOSE: **SNR**

- The “Schools as a Neighborhood Resource” (SNR) program is a community-based program designed to provide recreational, educational, cultural, family, and civic/community activities in city areas considered service deficient.
- Classes are offered to residence at no cost at the following locations.

- Persons interested in attending SNR programs are asked to complete a registration form. Program participants are requested to complete income information forms.
- Primary user age group is 10-65 years of age.

Programming is designed to improve self-image, foster a sense of belonging, nurture relationships and instill a sense of community while providing an opportunity for fun through:

Athletics – Basic instruction in basketball, volleyball, track, open gym, weightlifting, floor hockey, soccer, karate and swimming.

Aerobics – Low and high impact style, free form dance and power walking.

Fine Arts – Arts and Crafts.

Family Life/Community Forum – This program is designed to improve the quality of life of the neighborhood residents and to offer community groups the opportunity to utilize the facility for meetings and public service events.

Summer Tennis Program

- Provides tennis instruction to at least 120 City youth, ages 8-18
- Programs primary users are ages 8-18
- Teaches backhand, lob and forehand shot, how to serve, rules of a single and double games, and scoring
- Tennis Sessions are provided in am and pm sessions. AM sessions are held from 10:00 am to 12:00 noon and PM Sessions are held from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm.
