### **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC Incorporated to continue to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for one additional year.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 742-2018, passed June 4, 2018, this Council authorized the Director of Port Control to enter into Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC Incorporated ("ARINC") to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for a period of one year with three one-year options to renew; and

WHEREAS, an additional one year term is desired; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC to extend the term of their existing contract for one additional year to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the costs of the amendment shall not exceed \$58,406.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. 60 SF 001. (RQS 3001, RL 2022-57)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
