Ordinance No. 497-2022

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Finance is authorized to enter agreements with Rainey Institute, Center for Arts Inspired Learning, and The Music Settlement to provide arts and music programs for youth during the summer and/or fall of 2022 that will provide tools to prevent violence, develop skills and knowledge to overcome challenges associated with trauma and toxic stress, and to create opportunities for youth to live quality lives.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the cost of each agreement shall not exceed \$50,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-001-9997.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
