AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to exercise the third option to renew Contract No. LS 2019-24 with T & G Flying Club, Inc. for the lease of certain City-owned space in the Terminal Building at Burke Lakefront Airport, for the operation of a comprehensive flight training school, aircraft rental program, and related services for student pilots.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1106-18, passed October 8, 2018, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. LS 2019-24 with T & G Flying Club, Inc. for the lease of certain City-owned space in the Terminal Building at Burke Lakefront Airport, for the operation of a comprehensive flight training school, aircraft rental program, and related services for student pilots; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1106-18 requires further legislation before exercising the third option to renew on this contract; and

WHEREAS, for the use of the Leased premises, T&G shall pay the City an annual fee as specified in the contract; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to exercise the third option to renew Contract No. LS 2019-24 with T & G Flying Club, Inc. for the lease of certain City-owned space in the Terminal Building at Burke Lakefront Airport, for the operation of a comprehensive flight training school, aircraft rental program, and related services for student pilots. This ordinance constitutes the additional legislative authority required by Ordinance No. 1106-18 to exercise this option.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
