







One of the 100 Day Trackers to align with our scope of work- focusing on small businesses include the following:

- Establish a Small Business Administration Council to advise the Mayor on improving the city's small business environment.
- Barriers to capital continue to be a challenge for small businesses. The UBIZ is a solution to create an environment that gives small businesses who are coachable an opportunity to receive flexible capital.




Our scope of work could cover the following:

- 1) Deploy \$1 million of growth capital in 10 to 15 small businesses in Cleveland.
- 2) Provide a high intensity technical assistance through Becoming Bankable Construction and Restaurant Accelerator programs to 25 disadvantaged businesses in the city of Cleveland.
- **3)** Partner with the City of Cleveland Economic Development department and other service providers to facilitate two Access to Capital webinar/town hall series to educate residents on availability of various capital resources.



- 4) Provide a joint Minority certification program across the State MBE and City MBE to 25 Minority businesses with contract opportunities.
- 5) Ensure that the businesses being assisted through the above scope of work have a collective economic impact of:
 - A) \$3 million in new contracts and/revenue growth
 - **B)** Job creation and/ or retention of 30 living wage jobs
