Purpose: To sell and assign the Multifamily Housing Mortgage

Revenue Bond Series 2001B (Rainbow Terrace Apartments Project) to Vesta Corporation.

Background: Rainbow Terrace (Rainbow), located at 7310 Carson

Avenue in the Garden Valley neighborhood of Ward 5, contains 484 rental units for low to moderate income individuals and families. Vesta-Cleveland, LLC took over the property management in 1999 and in 2001 the City secured an Up-Front grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). CD referred back to ordinances 1226-01 and 1865-01, which provided some insight on the project. Rainbow, a HUD owned property, conveyed the title to the City and made the Up-Front grant available in an effort the carry out the out the City's public purpose of providing decent, safe and sanitary affordable housing. Cuyahoga County then issued

sanitary affordable housing. Cuyahoga County then issued \$11,701,500 in bonds which the City purchased using the Up-Front grant. By issuing bonds it allowed Vesta to be eligible for tax credits as well as an FHA loan – it basically acted as a conduit bond for other HUD funding. Vesta took on a loan with the City for the \$11,701,500. The

loan matures in 2047.

Proposed Terms: To accept a settlement payoff of the property for

\$4,000,000 and close the loan.
