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## Executive Summary Center for Disease Detection, LLC (CDD)

## Background/Purpose:

This legislation authorizes the Director of Public Health to enter into one or more contracts without competitive bidding with Center for Disease Detection, LLC for the purchase of lab services for reproductive health clinics that are needed under the Title X grant.

The Ohio Department of Health will no longer cover certain screening tests for certain patient populations that are in need of reproductive health services. CDD is the only lab service that contracts with the Ohio Department of Health to conduct screening tests for our patients at the Reproductive Clinics, and is the only agency that utilizes the current AFTIS software, which is currently used by clinical staff to upload and transmit patient information to ODH.

This contract will cover all the screening tests listed on the attached documentation. The expanded lab services will assist CDPH in increasing patient volume; manage chronic disease (including HIV) and providing care to more vulnerable populations to optimize better outcomes and will enable CDPH to provide high quality reproductive services to an underserved population.

This will allow CDPH to meet grant requirements.
