

Ordinance No. 464-2022 AS AMENDED

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC Incorporated to continue to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for one additional year and to further amend the contract to authorize ARINC to provide five workstations, software licenses, and training.

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 742-2018, passed June 4, 2018, this Council authorized the Director of Port Control to enter into Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC Incorporated (“ARINC”) to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport for a period of one year with three one-year options to renew; and

WHEREAS, an additional one year term is desired and to further amend the contract to authorize ARINC to provide five workstations, software licenses, and training; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS 2018-188 with ARINC to extend the term of their existing contract for one additional year to provide maintenance, operation and management services for City-owned common use facilities at Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and to further amend the contract to authorize ARINC to provide five workstations, software licenses, and training.

Section 2. That the amendment shall be prepared by the Director of Law.

Section 3. That the costs of the amendment shall not exceed ~~\$58,406.00~~ \$110,824.00 and shall be paid from Fund No. ~~60 SF 001~~ Nos. 60 SF 001, 60 SF 104, 60 SF 106, and 60 SF 141. (RQS 3001, RL 2022-57)

Section 4. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
