## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of the Department of Community Development to enter into agreement with Westown Community Development Corporation for the Westown CDC Housing Stabilization Code Enforcement Program through the use of Ward 11 Casino Revenue Funds.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of the Department of Community Development is hereby authorized to enter into agreement effective July 1, 2022, with Westown Community Development Corporation for the Westown CDC Housing Stabilization Code Enforcement Program for the public purpose of eliminating slum and blight in City of Cleveland neighborhoods through the use of Ward 11 Casino Revenue Funds.

Section 2. That the cost of said contract shall be in an amount not to exceed \$70,420 and shall be paid from Fund No. 10 SF 188.

Section 3. That the Director of Law shall prepare and approve said contract and that the contract shall contain such terms and provisions as he deems necessary to protect the City's interest.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
