The FirstEnergy Stadium is owned by the City of Cleveland and operated by the Browns.			
	This legislation will authorize the Directors of the Department or Public Works and/or the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects to perform or cause to be performed the improvements listed below for the FirstEnergy Stadium. These improvements have been reviewed and physical conditions inspected by MOCAP and have been deemed to be necessary Emergency Repairs and Capital Repairs, respectively, as defined in the Lease. The Audit is required per the Lease to be performed every 5 years. The last Audit was conducted in 2018.
