Accepting Funds for Central Recreation Center Park & new East 26th Street construction

Purpose: This Department requests legislation to authorize the

Director of the Mayor's Office of Capital Projects or Director of Public Works to accept grants and gifts from public and private entities for new E. 26th Street roadway and new park adjacent to Central Recreation Center; to enter into one or more agreements for the purpose of making and accepting E. 26th Street from Community College Avenue to Central Avenue for public use; to make

the public improvement for a new park at Central

Recreation Center; to enter into one or more Professional Service contracts; to authorize the Division of Purchasing and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record all land

necessary in making the improvement, including but not

limited to gift, fee simple acquisitions, temporary

easements, permanent easements, and work agreements; to add any and all funds as authorized by Director of

Finance.

Description: As part of Cuyahoga County's Central Surge Initiative,

aimed at impacting Cleveland's Central neighborhood, the County will arrange for the preparation of construction plans and specifications, including engineering reports, and for the supervision and administration of the construction cost and contribute 100% towards construction of a new East 26th Street between

Community College Avenue and Central Avenue and grant \$1,000,000 to City towards construction costs for a new park adjacent to the Central Recreation Center. The roadway improvement includes constructing 785 feet of new concrete roadway, new sidewalks, curbs, ADA compliant curb ramps, storm sewer, water main, sanitary sewer, street lighting, electric power ductbanks and other associated infrastructure to support adjacent

CMHA housing development.
