Ord. No. 572-2022

By Council Members Kazy and Griffin (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more agreements with CHN Housing Partners to administer energy, water, and sewer conservation services to low-income homeowners, for the Divisions of Water, Water Pollution Control, and Cleveland Public Power, Department of Public Utilities, for a period up to one year, with one option to renew for a period up to one year, exercisable by the Director of Public Utilities. Estimated Cost: \$925,000

Ord. No. 573-2022

By Council Members Kazy and Griffin (by departmental request)

Authorizing the Director of Public Utilities to enter into one or more requirement contracts without competitive bidding with BissNuss Inc., the Northeast Ohio Regional representative of various proprietary equipment and services, in order to maintain and replace existing components of various chemical feed and related systems, for the Division of Water, Department of Public Utilities, for term of two years.
