<u>AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION</u> Withdrawing objection to the transfer of ownership of a D2, D2X, D3 and D3A Liquor Permit at 2317 Denison Avenue, 1st floor front, basement and patio, and repealing Resolution No. 935-2021 objecting to said permit.

WHEREAS, this Council objected to a transfer of ownership of a D2, D2X, D3 and D3A Liquor Permit to Hunt Enterprises, LLC, DBA Quisqueya La Bella Restaurant, 2317 Denison Avenue, 1st floor front, basement and patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permit No. 4073888 by Resolution No. 935-2021 adopted by the Council on October 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to withdraw its objection to the above permit and consents to said permit; and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1</u>. That objection to the transfer of ownership of a D2, D2X, D3 and D3A Liquor Permit to Hunt Enterprises, LLC, DBA Quisqueya La Bella Restaurant, 2317 Denison Avenue, 1st floor front, basement and patio, Cleveland, Ohio 44109, Permit No. 4073888 by Resolution No. 935-2021, containing such objection, be and the same is hereby repealed and that this Council consents to the immediate permit thereof.

<u>Section 2</u>. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
