

Ordinance No. 868-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Public Safety to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives relating to reimbursement of overtime salary costs and other costs incurred by the Cleveland Division of Police in providing resources to assist the ATF, terminating on September 30, 2027.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Public Safety is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (“ATF”) relating to reimbursement of overtime salary costs and other costs, including but not limited to travel, fuel, training, and equipment, incurred by the Cleveland Division of Police in providing resources to assist the ATF. The MOU shall be substantially in the form placed in **File No. 868-2022-A**. The Director of Public Safety is authorized to file all papers and execute all documents necessary to receive the funds under this ordinance, and the funds are appropriated for this purpose.

Section 2. That the term of the MOU shall terminate on September 30, 2027.

Section 3 That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
