#### Res. No. 694-2022

By Council Members Conwell, Bishop and Hairston (by departmental request)

An emergency resolution declaring the intent to vacate a portion of Rockhurst Avenue N.E. (12 feet wide) between East 105<sup>th</sup> Street and East 107<sup>th</sup> Street.

#### Ord. No. 757-2022

An emergency ordinance authorizing the purchase by one or more standard and requirement contracts for the purchase, lease, or lease with option to purchase, of various on-road vehicles, apparatus, and off-road equipment, cabs, bodies, and accessories, equipment, and other aftermarket items necessary to equip the vehicles authorized for their intended purposes, including vehicle rehabilitation, training, and inspections, as needed, for the Departments of Public Utilities and Port Control.

Estimated Cost: \$6,665,500

**Ord. No. 820-2022**

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to accept a grant from the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council for the NOPEC Energized Community Grant Program for various energy efficiency and City facility improvement projects; determining the method of making the public improvement of implementing the projects; authorizing the Director to enter into one or more contracts for the making of the public improvement; and authorizing one or more standard, requirement, professional services, or other contracts or agreements needed to implement this ordinance.
