SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 765-2022 to authorize the Director of Public

Safety to enter into contracts or amendments to Contract No. CT 6002 SG 2022-015 with Accipiter Radar Corporation to permit Accipiter to sell access to radar data derived from the City's radar system to third parties in exchange for certain maintenance and upgrade services from Accipiter at no charge to the City; and to amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 674-2020, passed September

9, 2020. This legislation also contains an amendment.

Ordinance No. 765-2022, if passed by Council, would authorize the Director of Public Safety to enter into contracts or amendments to Contract No. CT 6002 SG 2022-015 with Accipiter Radar Corporation (Accipiter) to permit Accipiter to sell access to radar data derived from the City's radar system to third parties for a ten year period. In exchange, Accipiter will provide, at a minimum, annual system maintenance, updates, cloud services, system repairs and related services to the City for a period of three years at no charge to the City. In addition, for the final seven years of the agreement, Accipiter will continue to provide these annual services at a yearly cost not to exceed \$17,857.14 per year.

This amendment to the agreement will provide the City with a fully functioning radar system and the above listed maintenance and repair services for a period of ten years ensuring uninterrupted radar access to assist in our security efforts.
