DESCRIPTION:	Legislation authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) to provide services necessary for snow and ice removal, general routine maintenance and repair of State Route 176 of highway from mile marker 10.13 to mile marker 13.93. Routine maintenance shall include but is not limited to litter pick up, mowing, vegetation control, pothole patching, lane striping, storm sewer cleaning, ditch operations, shoulder sweeping, overhead lighting maintenance & guardrail repair.
LEGISLATIVE PURPOSE:	Passage of this legislation is necessary to care for, supervise, and control of the public highways within our municipal corporation by the Ohio Department of Transportation.
CURRENT CONTRACT:	None
NEW CONTRACT TERM:	For a period of one year with two, one-year options to renew, exercisable by the Director of Public Works.
ESTIMATED CONTRACT AMOUNT:	\$193,407.91
