Ord. No. 900-2022

An emergency ordinance directing a portion of the City's Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund payment to the City's COVID-19 response by authorizing the Director of Community Development to enter into one or more loan and grant agreements with various individuals and entities to finance affordable housing and to address vacant or abandoned properties, to be encumbered beginning March 3, 2021, and ending December 31, 2024; to enter into other similar agreements; and to apply for and accept grants and gifts.
