AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend Section 51 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, passed March 29, 2021, as amended, relating to compensation for various classifications.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That Section 51 of Ordinance No. 194-2021, as amended by

Ordinance No. 1073-2021, passed November 29, 2021, is amended to read as follows:

<u>Section 51. Housing Court Employees.</u> Salaries and compensation in the following classifications shall be fixed by the appointing authority in accordance with the schedule appearing after each classification:
