Please prepare a request for legislation authorizing the Director of Finance, on behalf of the Cleveland Municipal Court, to expend grant funds from the Ohio Mental Health & Addiction Services (OHMAS) through the The Alcohol, Drug Addiction and Mental Health Services Board of Cuyahoga County (ADAMHS Board)

The original term of the Grant will be July 1, 2022 with no expired term for usage. The amount of the grant is \$18,345.00. With the assistance of our partners, the project will implement creative approaches to expand access to evidence-based supervision and treatment services for defendants of The Greater Cleveland Drug Court.

Program Name: Addiction Treatment Program – FY23

Description: This program is submitted by the Cleveland Municipal Court (CMC) to

expand access to evidence-based supervision and treatment services for defendants of the Greater Cleveland Drug Court. The goal of the program is to reduce recidivism and substance abuse among high-risk participants with substance use disorders thereby increasing their likelihood of

successful long term recovery.

Grant Period: Beginning July 1, 2022 with no expiration date of funds usage

#### **Addiction Treatment Program (ATP) Administrative Funds**

Court Administrative funds may be utilized at the court's discretion to assist in administering the ATP; the funds are intended to assist courts in serving more clients and covering staff time for collaboration with other agencies involved in the ATP, notifying Managed Care Plans, if applicable, and other responsibilities related to serving ATP clients. Once these funds are disbursed to the Court, they are not to be included in your quarterly report as a Treatment or Recovery Support.

Provider Administrative funds to Certified SUD providers may be utilized for case managers/clinicians to attend treatment team meetings at the court or for court appearances that are not billable to insurance. These funds may also be used to assist the providers with administrative costs involved with delivering Recovery Support services that are not reimbursed by the client's insurance. Some examples may include: case manager hourly rate to assist a client in purchasing work or interview clothing, emergency basic need items, coordinating housing and/or transportation. Once these funds are disbursed to the Provider, they are not to be included in your quarterly reports as a Treatment or Recovery Support.

The FY23 Court and Provider Administrative funds have been determined by using a percentage of the State GRF funds available for ATP and divided among the number of Courts Participating and calculated based on the total number of clients served by each Court in FY22. The Court Administrative funds are to be taken out of your Board's ATP allocation (or carryover) and passed on to the Court. The Provider Administrative funds are also to be taken out of your Boards ATP allocation (or carryover) and disbursed to providers, as applicable. These amounts have been subtracted from your ATP allocation and do not go under the categories of Treatment or Recovery Supports on your ATP Quarterly Report.
