Ordinance No. 1279-2022

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Designating the Sidaway Bridge as a Cleveland Landmark.

WHEREAS, under Chapter 161 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, the Cleveland Landmarks Commission (the "Commission") has proposed to designate the Sidaway Bridge as a landmark; and

WHEREAS, the owner of the Sidaway Bridge has been properly notified and has consented in writing to the proposed designation; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has recommended designation of the Sidaway

Bridge as a landmark and has set forth certain findings of fact constituting the basis for its decision; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the immediate preservation of the public peace, property, health, and safety in that the immediate protection of the historic landmark is necessary to safeguard the special historical, community, or aesthetic interest or value in the landmark; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Sidaway Bridge whose street address in the City of Cleveland is Sidaway Avenue over Kingsbury Run, Cuyahoga County Auditor's Permanent Parcel Number is 125-13-001, and is also known as the following described property:

Situated in the City of Cleveland, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio; and known as being part of Sublots Nos. 64, 65, 69, 70, 72, 73, 87 and the unnumbered lot in Meyer & Thoman's Allotment of part of Original Newburgh Township Lot No. 329 as recorded in Volume 7 of Maps, Page 4 of Cuyahoga County Records;

Beginning at a point on the Southeasterly line of Sidaway Ave. S.E. at the Southwesterly corner of lands deeded to the Cleveland Metropolitan Housing Authority (pp#125-18-042);

Thence Southwesterly, along the Southeasterly line of Sidaway Ave. S.E., to a point on the Easterly line of East 67th Street (50' wide);

Thence Northerly, along the Easterly line of said East 67th Street, to a point at the intersection of the Easterly extension of the Northerly line of Sidaway Ave. S.E.;

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Thence Westerly, along the Easterly extension of the Northerly line of Sidaway Ave., to a point on the Northwesterly line of Sidaway Ave. S.E.;

Thence Northeasterly, along the Northwesterly line of Sidaway Ave. S.E., to a point at the southeasterly corner of lands deeded to the City of Cleveland (pp#125-17-026);

Thence Southeasterly, along the prolongation of aforementioned lands, to the point of origin.

Designation is for all of the operational and structural components of the Sidaway Bridge connecting East 67th Street (50' wide) and Anita Kennedy Road S.E. (60' wide) only.

Legal Description approved by Eric Westfall, Acting Section Chief, Plats, Surveys and House Numbering Section

which in its entirety is a property having special character or special historical or aesthetic value as part of the development, heritage, or cultural characteristics of the City, State, or the United States, is designated a landmark under Chapter 161 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976.

Section 2. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
