WHEREAS, Section 115-5 of the Charter of the City of Cleveland, effective November 2, 2021, requires that the Mayor appoint 13 members to the Community Police Commission, with approval of the Council; that three of the appointments are nominated by the Council; that the term dates of the initial appointees are determined by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 115-5, the Mayor and the Council, along with community members, reviewed and made recommendations from more than 200 applications; to ensure compliance with the Charter, the recommendations were carefully evaluated and finalists completed an extensive interview process; and

WHEREAS, this Council has nominated three people (File No. 1289-2022) and has received recommendations from Council's Mayor's Appointments Committee (File No. 1290-2022); and

WHEREAS, this resolution constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, property, health or safety; now, therefore,
