# Ordinance No. 1232-2022 AS AMENDED

By Council Members Hairston and Griffin (by departmental request)

#### **AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE**

Authorizing the Director of City Planning to employ one or more professional consultants to produce a North Coast Lakefront Master Plan; and authorizing the director to enter into one or more contracts with various entities or agencies to perform community engagement activities relating to the production and/or implementation of the Master Plan, for a period of one year, with a one year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of City Planning.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of City Planning is authorized to employ by contract or contracts one or more consultants or one or more firms of consultants for the purpose of supplementing the regularly employed staff of the several departments of the City of Cleveland in order to provide professional services necessary to produce a North Coast Lakefront Master Plan, including but not limited to, items relative to transforming our community's relationship to Lake Erie and to creating a world class, people-centric, place-based, holistic plan with a guiding vision for connecting community, including current and future Cleveland residents, to the lakefront.

Contracts authorized under this section shall not exceed \$500,000.

The selection of the consultant or consultants for the services shall be made by the Board of Control on the nomination of the Director of City Planning from a list of qualified consultants available for employment as may be determined after a full and complete canvass by the Director of City Planning for the purpose of compiling a list. The compensation to be paid for the services shall be fixed by the Board of Control. The contract or contracts authorized shall be prepared by the Director of Law, approved by the Director of City Planning, and certified by the Director of Finance.

Section 2. That the Director of City Planning is authorized to enter into one or more contracts with various entities or agencies to perform community engagement activities relating to the production and/or implementation of the Master Plan, for a

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period of one year, with a one year option to renew, exercisable by the Director of City Planning. <u>Contracts authorized under this section shall not exceed \$400,000.</u>

Section 3. That the cost of the contract or contracts authorized <u>under this</u> ordinance shall not exceed \$900,000 and shall be paid from Fund No. 01-0110-6380. (RQS 0110, RLA 2022-100).

<u>Section 4.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
