AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, relating to allocation of Casino Revenues.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, are hereby amended to read, respectively, as follows:

An emergency ordinance allocating <u>15%-50%</u> of Cleveland Casino Revenues received by the City for use by Cleveland City Council.

<u>Section 1.</u> That Cleveland Casino revenues received by the City shall be deposited into the general fund and fifteen percent (15%) fifty percent (50%) shall be allocated for use by Cleveland City Council.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the existing Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
