

Ordinance No. 97-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

To amend the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, relating to allocation of Casino Revenues.

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, are hereby amended to read, respectively, as follows:

An emergency ordinance allocating ~~15%~~ 50% of Cleveland Casino Revenues received by the City for use by Cleveland City Council.

Section 1. That Cleveland Casino revenues received by the City shall be deposited into the general fund and ~~fifteen percent (15%)~~ fifty percent (50%) shall be allocated for use by Cleveland City Council.

Section 2. That the existing Title and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1477-11, passed October 17, 2011, are hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
