

Ordinance No. 134-2023

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

Authorizing the Director of Port Control to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS2019-051 with EnviroScience, Inc. to provide additional environmental analytical services for a period not to exceed twelve months, for the Department of Port Control.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance No. 1208-15, passed October 26, 2015, the Director of Port Control entered into Contract No. PS2019-051 with EnviroScience, Inc. to provide professional environmental analytical laboratory services for the Department of Port Control; and

WHEREAS, continuing services under the contract and providing additional services are necessary for a period not to exceed twelve months; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

Section 1. That the Director of Port Control is authorized to enter into an amendment to Contract No. PS2019-051 with EnviroScience, Inc. to extend the term of the contract for a period not to exceed twelve months and provide additional environmental services for the Department of Port Control. All other terms and conditions of Contract No. PS2019-051 will remain the same.

Section 2. That the cost of the amendment to Contract No. PS 2019-051 shall be paid from Fund Nos. 60 SF 001 and 60 SF 141. (RQS 3001, RL 2023-2)

Section 3. That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
