- SUBJECT: Resolution No. 43-2023 approving the adoption of the Countywide All Hazards Mitigation Plan for Cuyahoga County, 2022 Update

Resolution No. 43-2023, if passed by Council, will approve adoption of the 2022 Update of the Countywide All Hazards Mitigation Plan (AHMP) for Cuyahoga County.

Adoption of the AHMP enables the City to maintain eligibility to continue to apply for federal hazard mitigation grant funds available through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 requires communities to review and revise the plan at least every five years and the 2022 Update reflects that review and revision. In addition, an AHMP is beneficial for local planning efforts during emergencies.
