## Ordinance No. 250-2023

By Council Members Starr, Kelly, Bishop and Griffin (by departmental request) AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE Authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Soccer Foundation to accept a donation of two minipitch soccer fields with sponsor logos, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Soccer Foundation has indicated a desire to make a donation of two mini-pitch soccer fields with sponsor logos, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location; and

WHEREAS, sponsors for the soccer fields include the U.S. Soccer Foundation, Black Players for Change, the Black Women's Player Collective, Mosco Lighting, and Adidas; and

WHEREAS, the two locations where the mini-pitch soccer fields will be installed are Lonnie Burten Park and Halloran Park; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance constitutes an emergency measure providing for the usual daily operation of a municipal department; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLEVELAND:

<u>Section 1.</u> That the Director of Public Works is authorized to enter into an agreement with the U.S. Soccer Foundation to accept a donation of two mini-pitch soccer fields with sponsor logos, with components that include lighting, fencing, goals, benches, ADA-compliant access, and lockable storage at each location. The agreement shall include a provision that the City is required to lay asphalt at both sites prior to installation of the mini-pitch soccer fields. The value of the mini-pitch fields and components are approximately \$100,000 each, for an approximate total of \$200,000.

<u>Section 2.</u> That this ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and, provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
