Arts, Culture, Creative Economy

- Two-year, grant funded (The Cleveland Foundation) position that aims to accomplish the following:
 - Develop and oversee a strategic planning effort to understand and create the scaffolding for the Arts, Culture and Creative Economy within City Hall
 - Establish a proof of concept for how creatives might integrate into public service
 - Enhance the work and creative economy of the creative ecosystem with a focus on uplifting Black, Indigenous, Hispanic/Latine, Asian American Pacific Islander, et al. creatives in concert with the City's efforts in economic development
 - Coordinate possible large-scale transformative art initiatives
 - Develop a work plan that addresses, policy, ordinances, cross-departmental initiatives
 - Oversee the strategic distribution of ARPA funds by the end of the two-year term
