Res. No. 44-2023

By Council Members Starr, Bishop and Hairston (by departmental request)

An emergency resolution declaring the intent to vacate all of East 59th Street, from Central Avenue to Hawthorne Avenue and all of Hawthorne Court, from East 59th Street to East 61st Street.

Ord. No. 117-2023

By Council Members Bishop, Griffin and Gray (by departmental request)

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Works to enter into one or more Qualified Management Agreements with the Highland Park Golf Foundation, an Ohio non-profit corporation, for professional services to manage, operate, and improve the Highland Park Golf Course and surrounding landscape, for the Division of Recreation, Department of Public Works, for a period up to thirty years; and authorizing the Director to apply for and accept any gifts, grants, or services from any public or private entity.

An emergency ordinance authorizing the Director of Capital Projects to apply for and accept a grant from the United States Department of Transportation for the Reconnecting Cleveland I-90 Program; authorizing the Director to employ one or more professional consultants to provide a feasibility study for the I-90 corridor between East 22nd Street and Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive; authorizing other agreements; and authorizing the Commissioner of Purchases and Supplies to acquire, accept, and record for right-of-way purposes real property and easements.
